We would like to inform you that a new camera controlled car park management system is going to be implemented at Two Rivers Medical Centre over the coming weeks.

Once the new terminal machines and signage are in place, motorists will be required to enter their registration into the terminal to be entitled to free parking for the duration of their stay.

Details of the new parking restrictions are below.

The aim is to improve access for patients attending for appointments by reducing levels of unauthorised parking.

Parking is subject to the terms and conditions that apply and are set out within this notice (the "Parking Contract"). By parking, waiting or otherwise remaining within this private car park, you agree to comply with these terms and conditions (the "Parking Contract") and are authorised to park only if you follow these terms, including making payment where directed, entering your registration details into the nearest motor permit system, if you fail to comply, you are liable to pay the fee for unauthorised parking (the "Parking Charge"). This Parking Contract shall form the entire agreement between the parties. Any proposal to waive any part of this Parking Contract shall not be valid unless authorised in writing by ParkingEye Ltd. By entering this private car park, you consent, for the purpose of car park management to the capturing of photographs of the vehicle and registration by the attendant and to the processing of this data, together with any data provided by you or others via the payment or permit system, correspondence, telephone, or in person, by ParkingEye Ltd and any authorised subcontractor to check compliance with the Parking Contract. Furthermore, you consent to the processing of this data to request registration keeper details from the DVLA, where the Parking Contract is not adhered to and a enforcement is undertaken manually via ANPR, or to the Parking Charge notice is issued manually by the attendant. Our services include Parking Charge insurance, it will be notified to the registered keeper of your, where the ANPR system identifies non-compliance with the Parking Contract, and may be reduced to the relevant driver on receipt of the driver's valid name and address, or it will be notified to the driver, where an attendant identifies non-compliance with the Parking Contract, and may subsequently be notified to the registered keeper. Personal data may also be shared with the DVLA, PCN's, mail service providers, credit reference agencies, collection agencies or authorities for the purpose and any authorised subcontractors. A reduction of at least 40% of the Parking Charge will be available for a period of 14 days. Failure to pay the Parking Charge within this period will result in the full amount becoming payable. Where Parking Charges remain unpaid beyond 28 days, recovery charges in respect of further action may apply. A charge reflecting the cost to ParkingEye may apply for payments made with a credit/debit card.
